Categories

Arts

Excellence or achievement in any of the following: visual arts (painting, photography, sculpture, etc.), dance, literature, music, theater.

Civil/Non-Profit

The collaboration of efforts that include the use of public/private funds in a partnership effort to enhance the quality of life in her community.

Business and Commerce

Contributions of private enterprise that have an economic impact at the local, state and/or international level to benefit business and industry.

Education

Efforts that promote or benefit education at all levels.

Environmental

Contributions that promote the preservation and conservation of our environment.

Health

Contributions that have made a significant impact toward healthy living in her community through education, preservation or medical services.

Humanitarian

An individual whose personal effort has contributed to the community as a whole.

Law Enforcement/Public Service

An individual whose public service has impacted her community.

Senior

An individual over age 55 that exemplifies the contributions, strengths and commitment to senior citizens.

Youth

An individual under 21 who, through personal involvement and endeavors, has answered the challenge of good character and citizenship.
